

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

CLEANING SOLUTIONS

- Use a mild soap or detergent in lukewarm water solution & a soft, clean chamois cloth.
- Acrylic Cleaner (for dirt and fingerprints) & Antistatic Cleaner (cleaner appearance) are ideal for cleaning acrylic.
- **DO NOT USE: Strong solvents or harsh chemicals, ammonia-based cleaners, paper towels or rough cloths, brushes or scratchy sponges.**

CLEANING TIPS

- When washing, **DO NOT submerge your item in water.** Use a mildly soapy water solution and wipe with a chamois cloth. Dry well by blotting.
- When dusting, use a soft dry microfiber or cotton cloth. This removes dust without scratching the surface.
- For scratches, use Braso and wipe gently in a circular motion. Wipe clean with a damp cloth.

CLEANING PRINTED AREAS

- Use a soapy lukewarm water solution and remember to dry the surface with a soft cloth - NO PAPER TOWELS.
- When cleaning, avoid heavy wiping motions. It is advised to gently pat the surface with a soft cloth to prevent damage to the printing.
- **AVOID sharp objects, harsh chemicals and excessive moisture near printed areas (minimize the use of water).**



DUST

Only with a clean soft damp cloth made of cotton or chamois. Wipe gently.



WASH

Mild soap or detergent and lukewarm water solution. Rinse well with water. Dry by blotting using soft cloth.



SCRATCHES

Use Braso and soft cloth in a circular motion by hand to polish. Afterwards wash with soapy water.
